BATHURST STREET STANDPIPE TO COMMENCE OPERATIONS THROUGH AVDATA SYSTEM

The potable water standpipe near Lachlan Shire Council's depot in Bathurst Street, Condobolin, has now commenced operation through the AVDATA system. Currently, users can only access this standpipe service during business hours.

The AVDATA system will afford users the convenience of 24/7 access to this potable water service. All users will need to obtain a key tag (during business hours) from Lachlan Shire Council's administration building in Condobolin to access the system and will be account-billed for water extracted.

Fees for the current financial year, ending 30 June 2018, are as follows:

Key Tag Deposit (refundable)	\$42.00
Standpipe Fee (minimum)	\$5.00
Standpipe Fee (per kL)	\$3.65

If you have a business as a drinking water carter, you must now register your business activity with Lachlan Shire Council. It is important that water carters follow the requirements set out by NSW Health to ensure that waterborne pathogens are not present within the drinking water being transported.
