

WORK IS NOT TO COMMENCE WITHOUT PRIOR CONSENT

THIS CONSENT IS SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS

1. The applicant is to ensure all works, including signs and barriers are to be in accordance with the relevant Australian Standards and WorkCover requirements. All signage needs to be erected by an authorised person in accordance with the Roads and Traffic Authority's Traffic Control at Worksites Manual.
2. Lachlan Shire Council authorises the work under the Act and consents to the applicant carrying out the works within, over or across the road reserves applicable to the road in accordance with the Act subject to the terms of this agreement. This consent **does not** constitute permission under the Environment Planning and Assessment Act.
3. Failure to install signage correctly, maintain signage and comply with AS 1742.3 requirements may result in this consent being withdrawn and future applications being refused.
4. Prior to any activities occurring the applicant provide evidence to Council of current cover for:
 - a. Public Liability insurance cover of minimum \$20 Million,
 - b. Workers Compensation certificate of currency (if applicable);
 - c. Personal Accident insurance policy covering volunteers (if applicable);
5. The applicant shall comply with all applicable legislation relating to Workplace Health & Safety.
6. This consent is not transferrable. It is issued solely to the permit holder and their authorised agents.
7. The applicant/permit holder shall pay any applicable fees or charges as may be determined from time to time by Council (*currently nil for S138 consent*).
8. Council may only be contracted to undertake work associated with this consent through a "private works agreement" and charged as quoted or at cost (including overheads) as applicable.
9. All underground services will be located prior to any works undertaken by the applicant and consultation completed with the appropriate authorities. "Dial before you dig" information must be kept on site and be available for inspection at the request of Council staff as required.
10. The applicant will notify Council of any damages caused during works and Council shall not be responsible for any of these damages incurred by the applicant
11. The land on which the activity occurs must be maintained in a clean and tidy condition during the activity. Any soil disturbance created by the activity must be repaired to original condition within one month of completing the activity, with allowance for settling of the soil;
12. Trees located within the road reserve must not be removed
13. For projects that will involve traffic control being in place for **2 days** or more will require a completed signage checklist compliant with AS1742.3.A3 to be submitted to the Director of Infrastructure by 10.00 am every Monday for the proposed activities.
