The yellow lid bin is for the fortnightly collection of recyclables.

Recycling through the yellow bin system is for household items only.

What goes in this bin?



Paper & Cardboard Products



Rigid Plastic Containers



Steel & Aluminium Cans



Glass Bottles & Jars

Where does it go after collection?

Recyclable materials from the yellow lid bin are taken to a Materials Recovery Facility (MRF). Here they are sorted, baled, packed for transport and sent for reprocessing into new products.

We can then buy these products to help 'close the loop'.



Please **DO NOT** put these items in your yellow bin!

Hints and Tips



DO NOT place recyclables in plastic bags. They cannot be recycled and can cause issues at the MRF.



Wipe out or rinse containers in old washing up water before placing them in the bin.



Flatten cardboard containers to make more space in your recycling bin.



Remember to look for recycled products when shopping, this will help 'close the loop' and helps the environment even more!
