

Potable Water Standpipes Terms & Conditions

- 1. Council reserves the right to reject key tag registration applications, including those that are incomplete and/or not signed.
- 2. The applicant is responsible for the safekeeping of the standpipe key tag.
- 3. The applicant is responsible/liable for all water obtained through key tag access.
- 4. The purchase of a key tag requires a security deposit, which is refundable on return of the key tag.
- 5. If the key tag is damaged, lost or stolen the applicant must immediately report it to Council and forfeits the security deposit. If further water is required to be obtained from Council's automated standpipe, the applicant will be required to pay another security deposit and be issued with a new key tag.
- 6. Accounts for standpipe water usage will be invoiced on a monthly basis and payable within a 30-day term. Accounts with outstanding balances after the due date may have all associated key tags deactivated, preventing any further use of standpipes, until outstanding balances are paid in full.
- 7. The kilolitre usage rate and key deposit fee is updated on 1 July each year in accordance with Council's fees and charges.
